Updated Spring 2024

1. You must be a member in good standing of Mount Pleasant Potters' Guild (MPPG) to participate in our Pottery Sale fundraiser.
2. MPPG is the event sponsor providing the venue and shared retail transaction handling.
3. MPPG will retain a 20% commission from all revenue to cover expenses and contribute to ongoing MPPG operational costs and events.
4. MPPG assumes no product liability.
5. You agree to allow any photos taken of your pieces from the Pottery Sale to be posted on social media.
6. MPPG assumes no responsibility for damaged, broken or missing pots. All costs incurred due to breakage, damage or loss is assumed by the potter regardless of the cause.
7. MPPG deems all sales final. Any subsequent concerns or requests raised by a customer will be forwarded to the potter to be dealt with.
8. ALL participants are responsible for the following:
 - a. Ensuring all price stickers conform to our published guidelines.
 - b. Being present at the location both Saturday and Sunday to assist with setup on Saturday, running the event on Sunday and cleanup after the doors are closed to customers.
 - c. Performing tasks Saturday and Sunday as assigned by the Sales Coordinator.
